



“Spring Cleaning 101” Checklist:

Kitchen

- Clean and disinfect surfaces.

Bathroom

- Dust ceilings, vents and fans.
- Wash linens, shower curtain, draperies, blinds.
- Replace shower curtain liner.
- Scrub shower and tub.
- Clean inside and outside of toilet.
- Clean out inside of medicine cab and linen closet.
- Clean mirror.
- BONUS TIP:** Use newspaper* to wipe away window cleaner and avoid streaking.
- Clean and disinfect trashcan.
